## **German Architects at the world's biggest real estate fair**

### **MIPIM: State Secretary Adler inaugurates the „German Pavilion“**

State Secretary Gunther Adler will open the representation of German architects at the world's biggest real estate fair MIPIM on 15 March in Cannes, accompanied by the Vice-President of the Federal Chamber of German Architects, Prof. Ralf Niebergall, the German Consul General in Marseille, Dr. Dr. Rolf Friedrich Krause and the Chairman of the Board of the Bundesstiftung Baukultur, Reiner Nagel.

Until 18 March, German architects and engineers as well as relevant partner firms will present their competences, their efficiency „Made in Germany“ and their projects together with and supported by the Federal Ministry of Economics and Energy on the [GERMAN PAVILION](#) in the „Riviera Hall“ (Stand-No. R07.G38).

The Federal Chamber of German Architects (Bundesarchitektenkammer), is also part of the international jury for the MIPIM AWARDS this year, represented by Vice-President Prof. Ralf Niebergall, who was the only architect in the jury. For the MIPIM AWARDS this time, amongst others, four German projects are nominated, among them University Hospital Frankfurt, Goethe University from Nickl & Partner. The prices will be awarded in a gala during the MIPIM.

After the opening day there will be a diversified programme of events and discussion rounds at the GERMAN PAVILION: guests from politics and economics will discuss with the exhibitors on the stand themes like „The House of Tomorrow: Sustainability and Technology“, „Places for the Public: Communication, Health, Leisure“ as well as „Metropolis: Developing Urban Structures“. The GERMAN PAVILION – this year in a new design – is planned as an inviting meeting point and invites planners, building owners and investors to conduct conversations, intensify existing contacts and establish new ones. With this the MIPIM justifies its reputation as the ideal platform for planners with a global orientation. The internationally demanded competences of German planners will once again lead to a highly frequented GERMAN PAVILION.
